1) Alumni invited as judges for CARPE DIEM 2022: Under the aegis of the Literary Association, Department of English, DCT's Dhempe College of Arts and Science organized the initiation program 'Carpe Diem 2022' for students of First Year BA on October 04, 2022. The event, specially crafted by TY English students on the theme of Mythology, featured cosplay, skit, dance and a monologue competition. The competition was judged by the alumni of the Department - Ms. Sweta Sharma, Ms. Nasween Beig, Ms. Riya Nigale and Mr. Mayuresh Gaokar (English Honours batch of 2021-22). After the competition, the alumni shared their academic experiences with the students as well as provided valuable insights into building their co-curricular profile in the institution.



2) Alumni as Resource Persons for Skill Development Courses/Workshops:


- (i) Introduction to Translation: As part of the 30-hour Skill Development Course on Introduction to Translation conducted from February 17-June 15 2023, Dr. Tanvi Bambolkar was invited as a Resource Person to deliver a lecture on 'Translating News for Radio Broadcast and Introduction to web tools in translation'. Apart from being an avid translator of media-related material, children's literature and regional fiction, Dr. Bambolkar is also the recipient of the Sahitya Akademi Yuva Puraskar 2023. 21 participants enrolled for the workshop benefited from her expertise.
- (ii) Wordpecker 2.0: As part of the four-day skill development workshop titled 'Wordpecker 2.0' organized for school children, alumnae **Krutika Navelkar** and **Riya Nigaley** were invited as Resource Persons. Ms. Navelkar conducted a session on 'Voice Over' on 5th May 2023 while Ms. Nigaley conducted two sessions on 'Role a Tale' and 'Act it Out' on 5th and 6th May respectively.



3. The Art of Street-Play: Alumni Sahil Naik and Albert Rodrigues were invited as Resource Persons for a workshop on 'The Art of Street Play' organized as part of the Generic Elective course in Text and Performance on 29th October 2023. The Resource Persons provided valuable insights into the writing and performative aspects of street play for social causes. 23 students benefited from the same.

4. Coaching for entrance exams:

As a Department initiative to ensure students' progression, coaching classes were held from 20th to 25th February 2023 for students answering ranking/entrance tests for higher studies in English. **Mr. Mayuresh Gaokar and Ms. Sweta Sharma, alumni of the Department,** were invited as Resource Persons to provide special guidance to students answering the Goa University Annual Ranking Test (GU-ART). 28 students benefited from the same. The Workshop was divided into two sessions. Session One conducted by Dr. Bhat covered the topics of selection and evaluation of sources, important containers in citation and citing entries in bibliographic index according to MLA 9th edition. Session Two conducted by Dr. Pandit covered the topics of ethical writing, digital tools to be used in research (Mendeley, Zotero, Microsoft Office Indexing and Google Apps).
