

**Intellectual Property Rights**

25<sup>th</sup> January 2020 Seminar Hall

Under Institution Innovation Council, a State Level Workshop on IPR, Copyrights and Patenting in collaboration with Ignite – EDC Innovation Hub, Goa. It was organised by Convener- Dr. Karuna Singh -IPR Activity Coordinator (IIC), Organising Secretary-Preethi Poduval (IIC member), Treasurer- Mohit Suktankar (IIC Social Media Coordinator).

Total number of participants were 52, male-19 and female- 33. Students male-13, Students Female-14, Male Faculty-06, Female Faculty-19

The key objectives were to:

1. Awareness on patenting and copyrights
2. Training on filing patent
3. Understanding and elimination of Plagiarism
4. Concept clarification of IPR

Adv. Gautami Raiker, Founder and CEO, Law Mate explained the difference between a patent, a trademark and copyright and the general process a company must go through to acquire either of it. She explained the procedure of filing patent. To avoid plagiarism, she advised us to use software like URKUND etc.

Cyril D'Souza, Assistant Director, Goa Chapter of World Trade Centre (WTC) gave information about the role of WTC in providing support in processing Patent or Trademark and distribution of the final product. WTC work on improving quality, quantity and consistency of the product as well as facilitate with accurate trade information, digital marketing platforms, conference facilities. WTC is helping both novice and the pro-businessmen to make use of the global and domestic trading opportunities.

Dipak Parab, Nodal Officer with Patent Information Office, highlighted the process of patent filing from government point of view. He informed only 1% of the total taxpayer's money is being utilised in Research and Development. Due to lack of streamlined process on granting a patent, it is time consuming. India ranks 5<sup>th</sup> in the global patent holders while China leads with highest number of Patents. Thus, restructuring in the process of patent filing in order to make it faster.
