
Day 1 of the seminar began with the registration followed by the inaugural. Dr. Satish Shetye, Vice Chancellor (Retd.), Goa University; Director (Retd.), NIO, Goa, the Chief Guest of the seminar addressed the gathering in the presence of other dignitaries. Inaugral was then followed by the first guest lecture of the day by Prof. Srikanth Mutnuri Department of Biological Sciences, Dean, International Programmes and Collaboration Division; BITS-Pilani, Zuarinagar, Goa who delivered a lecture on the topic Decentralized Wastewater Treatment System wherein various strategies to manage the wastewater were discussed.

The first day of the seminar was concluded with a poster presentation by Undergraduate students, postgraduate students, and Ph.D scholars from various institutes in India and UK.

Day 2 of the seminar began with an amazing topic on "The AI Advantage – How AI Drives Scientific Breakthroughs in Health and Technology" by Prof. Momna Hejmadi Professor, Department of Life Sciences, University of Bath, United Kingdom.

The second topic for the day was on the " Use of Animal Models for Quality Research in Life Sciences" by Dr. Prabu D.






