The course was coordinated by **Ms. Reshma Zakane**, Assistant Professor, and was designed for **33 third-year B.Sc. Biotechnology students**. The course's objectives were to introduce students to fundamental research methods and academic research techniques, provide an understanding of research methodology, ethics, and scientific communication, and equip students with skills for proposal writing, research documentation, and plagiarism avoidance.





Total no of beneficiaries: Students: 33 (Males:4; Females:)


