Admission Process for International Students

Step 1: Choose Your Programme

Decide on the programme you wish to pursue and ensure you meet the basic qualifications. Visit Dhempe College's website at <http://dhempecollege.edu.in> to explore available programmes.

Step 2: First Level of Contact

Foreign students must identify relevant courses and send an email to the **Principal of the College**, with copies to:

- Foreign Student Advisor: fsa@unigoa.ac.in

Include scanned copies of:

- Previous marksheets
- Passport

- Supporting documents from your Board of Education/Institution

Step 3: Confirm Eligibility

Apply for an **Eligibility Certificate** through Goa University. Procedure available at: Goa University – Eligibility Certificate

Scholarships and Financial Options

- The **Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR)** offers scholarships to students from various countries.

- Students may also explore **study abroad schemes** available in their home countries.
- **Self-financing option:** Seats are available for students who can support themselves financially. Contact the Foreign Student Advisor (fsa@unigoa.ac.in) with details of your background and programme interest.

Visa Formalities

- A **regular student visa** is issued by Indian Missions abroad only to students with firm admission letters from Dhempe College and Goa University.
- Admission is permitted solely based on a visa granted to study at this institution.

Documents Required for Admission (Foreign Students)

For ICCR/Private Students (First Year)

- Duly filled online admission form
- Self-attested copy of 12th Std. marksheet
- Copy of English Proficiency Certificate
- Goa University Provisional Statement of Eligibility
- Self-attested copy of a valid passport and visa
- Copy of Residential Permit
- Copy of Agreement for Leave and Licence
- Letter from Consulate General of India/SS (Education)/Director, ICC (for ICCR students)
- Letter from Director, ICCR Regional Centre (for ICCR students)
- Medical Report (AIDS Test)
- Joining Report (for Afghan Scholars under ICCR)

For ICCR Students (Joining Report Requirements)

- Duly filled joining report form (two sets)
- Copies of marksheets (12th Std. for first year; I & II semesters for second year; I–IV semesters for third year)
- Copy of a valid passport and visa
- Goa University Provisional Statement of Eligibility
- Copy of Residential Permit
- Letters from Consulate General of India/SS (Education)/Director, ICC and ICCR Goa Region
- Copy of Bonafide Certificate
- Copy of Agreement for Leave and Licence
- Savings Bank account in **State Bank of India (SBI)** – submit a copy of the passbook to the ICCR office, Goa Region (through the College)
